**Tuesday 05 February: 6p.m. – 7.30 p.m.**

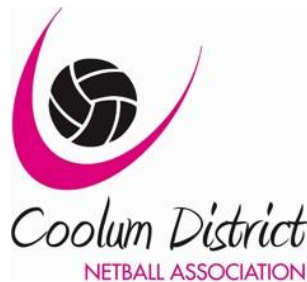

### **Terms and Conditions of Nomination**

- 1) **No Representative clothing is to be worn at trials.** Bike pants, netball skirt or sports shorts please.
- 2) Players must attend both Dates for trials. Players must submit in writing a valued reason for non-attendance prior to trial dates.
- 3) Upon being selected to a Coolum Representative Team a \$100 non-refundable deposit must be paid.
- 4) Final Balance will be due : Date to be advised.
- 5) Teams will be notified by the Coolum Executive committee by Email and will be published on the Coolum website after notification has been received.
- 6) Once teams are named, players withdrawing without valid reason, as determined by the Executive Committee, will not be entitled to any refunds.
- 7) Please bring water bottles, sunscreen and hats to trials.
- 8) Failure to comply with any of the above terms and conditions will see a player ineligible to trial.

## **2019 QPL INFORMATION**

All players who are successful in making QPL team at Coolum will play as a team on a Tuesday Evening in the Ladies competition. They can also play in their Club team on a Thursday night if they choose.

### **UNIFORMS**

The cost of a complete uniform pack is approximately \$360. This includes Jacket/Hooded sweatshirt, tracksuit pants, Dress, Bike Pants, Polo Shirt, Socks x 2 and Shorts. All of these items are compulsory. All players will receive an overnight bag, back pack and training shirt, compliments of our Sponsors.

### **Dates of Competition:**

The exact dates are yet to be confirmed. However the season will run from approx. mid May until late August/September depending if the team reaches the finals. Netball Queensland will release the draw once they know how many associations have entered teams. Games will usually be on a Sunday, with some weekend cluster events, where games will be spread over 2 days. Our Zone covers Caboolture to Rockhampton, so some long distance travel will be involved. Games will be played at indoor venues. All games are compulsory, there is a \$500 forfeit fee per game, so your commitment is for the season.

### **FEES**

Approximately \$350 at this stage – costs to be finalized once Netball Queensland can confirm the number of teams entering the competition. **This cost could change.** Please note this does not include uniforms, travel, meals. It does however include an accommodation equalization fee, which should help to cover the cost of accommodation for the weekend cluster events.

### **TRAINING**

Training Days – a training day will be confirmed once the coach is appointed. Our junior rep teams train on a Wednesday night
